FIRST LEGO League Jr. (BOOMTOWN BUILD) Playoff – Online Expo

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the *FIRST* LEGO League Jr. of FIRST Hong Kong Robotics Tournament 2019/20 is canceled. Although Teams cannot meet each other and share their innovative idea face-to-face, there is still another way to show your effort and talent throughout the season. Teams are invited to take a video to show their Model, Show-me Poster and Research in BOOMTOWN BUILD Online Expo!

1. Content

- Team can submit a maximum 10 minute-video in this online expo. Teams are encouraged to share their work and are assessed with the below rubrics.

Assessment items	Criteria
Exploration and Research (33%)	The Team has explored the problems and concerns of designing buildings (accessibility, environmentally friendly, durability, etc.). The Team understands the need(s) of designing buildings and suggests an innovative solution to tackle those needs.
Presentation (33%)	The model shows the research of the tournament of the Team; Mechanical structures and the program are creative; The model looks appealing to judges and is interesting and; The Team successfully and effectively operates the model. *WeDo 2.0 motor(s) must be used to build at least one motorized part and that motorized part must be programed by WeDo 2.0 software. *The model must contain the inspire model of this season from the inspire set. The Team has made one Show Me Poster to introduce their research, the model and the Team itself; Teammates have deep understanding of their research during the presentation; Contents of the presentation are clear and understandable to judges; The presentation is interesting and creative.
Teamwork (33%)	Team members have clear roles in the team; The team shows teamwork .

- 10-second buffer time is granted for each video. i.e. if a 3-mintue Robot Performance video is submitted, only the first 2 minutes and 40 seconds will be judged.

2. Certificates, Medals and Awards

Team members and coaches from each team will receive Certificates of Participation and BOOMTOWN BUILD Medals (shown below) after submitting the video. Teams with outstanding performance will also be presented with Awards.



3. Team Formation

- Only the Teams that originally enrolled FIRST Hong Kong Robotics Tournament 2019/20 are accepted.
- A Team could be formed by the same teammates.
- Teammates could be changed but age limitation applies. (Must be younger than 10 years old by 1 August 2020)

4. Copyright

- All contents in the video, including pictures and music if any, must be original, royalty-free or authorized by the originator(s) or the Teams may be disqualified.
- Written works, graphic works, photographs and sound recordings from the internet are protected by Copyright Ordinance. You are liable for copyright infringement if you use those works in your project without an explicit authorization or license from copyright owner.
- The participant(s) or school(s) should bear the legal responsibilities of the copyright of the video. Organizer is not required to bear the responsibilities mentioned above.
- Copyright of all qualified videos are co-owned by the Teams and the HKFYG. HKFYG will use these videos as promotional or educational purposes.

- The video(s) and/or poster should be uploaded to Google Drive/ Dropbox and COPY the link to a Video Submission Form (will be available in August) on or before 5 Oct 2020. <u>Please make sure that the video is authorized for the user with the link</u>.
- Teams must declare all contents in the videos and posters are original or royalty-free. If the elements
 have been already authorized by the originators, supporting documents must also be uploaded in this
 Submission Form.
